

In the event of an accident

Find out about the actions to take in the event of an accident.



Safety instructions

- avoid leaving the victim alone,
- provide emergency first aid by keeping the victim warm,
- give the alert, specifying: the victim's condition, the precise location and time of the accident,
- be available to rescuers for any clarifications,
- report the location of the victim in a visible manner while awaiting specialized help.

How to give the alert?

To alert the emergency services, dial 112

It should be remembered that the GSM coverage of the middle and high valleys remains very uneven and that, as a result, the use of mobile phones cannot be systematic.

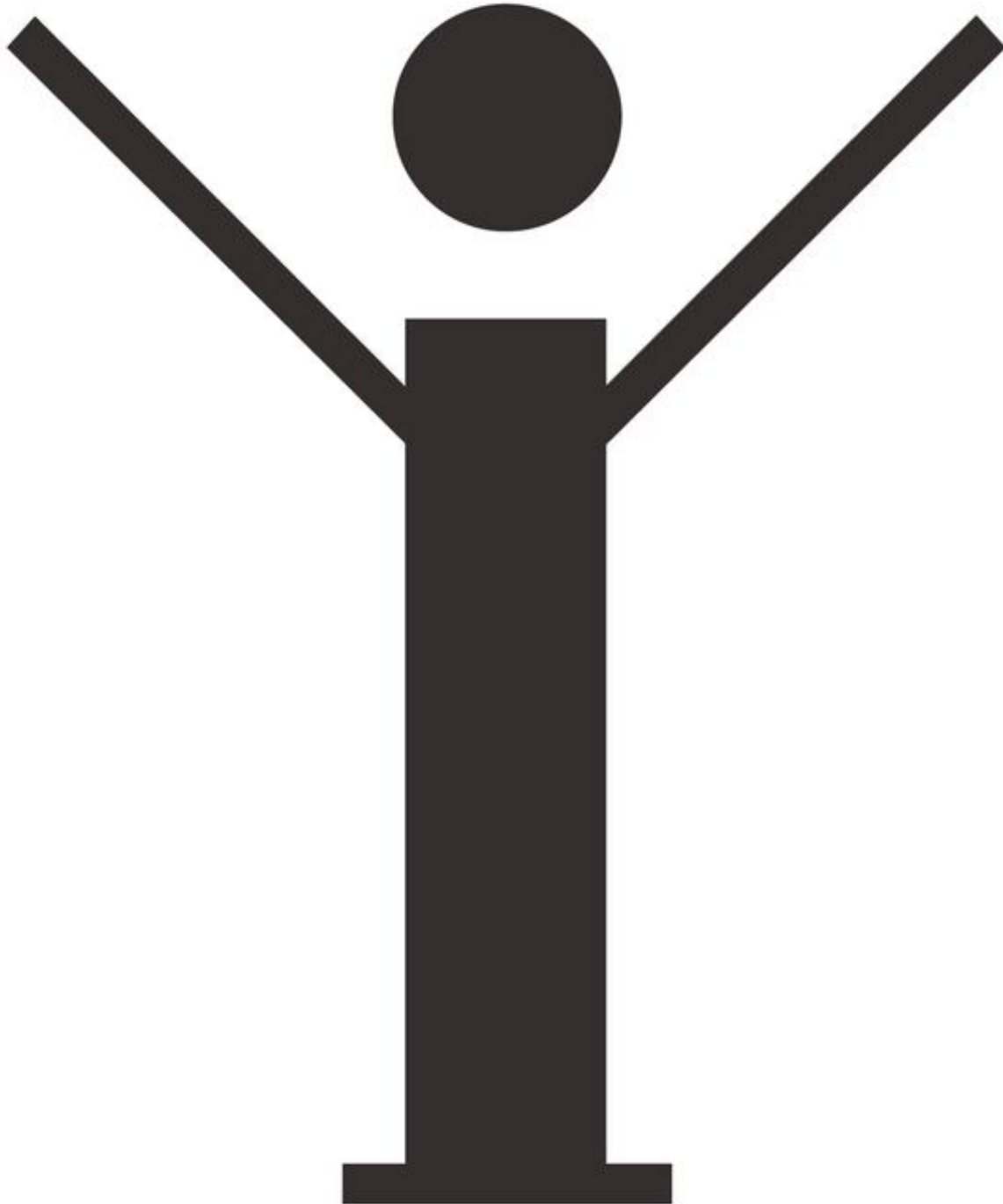
Content of the alert message, specify:

- Where: place, route, altitude, environment.
- Who: Identity, telephone number.
- What: type of accident, number of victims, severity.
- When: time of the accident.
- Weather: wind, visibility, precipitation.

In case of air rescue

- When the helicopter arrives, use the conventional signs below,
- protect your eyes and the victim from projections caused by the helicopter,
- never approach a helicopter before being invited to do so by the crew,
- watch the lifeguard's descent, which can inadvertently cause rock falls.
